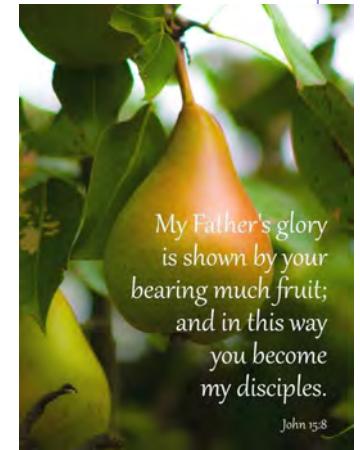

**Rev'd John's Sermon Outline**

Christ is the Vine - the branches are those who claim to be the followers of Christ!

The Fruitful branches are the true believers who by their living in union with Christ PRODUCE MUCH FRUIT.

ABIDING IN JESUS is Essential to Fruitfulness!

\*Vs 2 We learn that the act of cutting / pruning a branch is wounding - to lose such a branch is to lose part of our very self.

\* vs 5-6 .Jesus calls us to Remain in Him - Receiving Him as our Saviour and continue to live the Gospel.

\* To abide in Christ, we keep up the habit of constant close Communion with Him, through Prayer and regular Fellowship.  
We constantly lean on Him , Rest in Him , pour our hearts out to Him - He is our Fountain of Life and Strength, our chief Companion and Best friend.

\* vs 8 .When a vine bears 'much fruit'  
(the church , me and you)  
God is Glorified!
