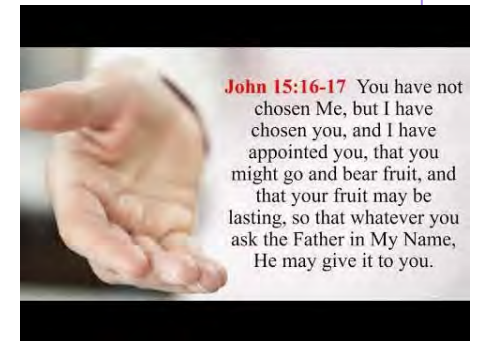

**Rev'd John's Sermon Outline**

John 15: 9 -18.

\*vs 10-11 Jesus emphatically says , the road of ABIDING consists in keeping His commandments.
